Music

This term, we will be learning to use tuned instruments such as xylophones and glockenspiels.

Design Technology

We will be building structures and exploring how they can be made stronger, stiffer and more stable, using a range of materials and components.

We will be making food for our picnic.

Maths

We are learning to compare weights and capacity, finding half and quarter of a given number, understanding place value, telling the time and having quick recall of mental addition and subtraction facts, as well as finding the change when using money.

Art and Design

We will be exploring colour, pattern, texture, line and shape to create natural sculptures while learning about the artists Andy Goldsworthy and Richard Long. We will also look carefully to sketch fruit and vegetables.

Computing

We will be learning about e-safety and how to email using our DB primary email.

R.E

We will be discussing what we can learn from creation stories.

Geography

We will be recapping the seven continents and five oceans.

English

In addition to our usual phonics and reading, we will be writing stories, reading and performing poems. We will also be reading a range of fiction and non-fiction texts about nature.

PE

We will be participating in team games. We will also practise and improve basic sports skills such as running, throwing and jumping.

Science

We will be able to identify and name a variety of common trees and wild plants. We will be able to describe the basic structure of flowering plants as well as identify and classify a range of animals.

History

We will be learning about changes within living memory for example we will be creating our own school timeline and family trees.
